Approved Minutes

Call to Order: 6:41pm

In Attendance: Rocky Cole, Patti Estrada, Kathy Fears, Matt Pelot, Kim Pelot, Mike Reichert, Lenny Gemar, Carol Lathrop, Amberly Scott, Rick Balke, Barb Pepi, Corey Stewart.

President's Report: Rocky reported that during games there have been many players wearing jewelry, barrettes, and not having a chin strap attached to their helmets. She stated that the umpires will be calling these things during games, and that an e-mail will be sent to all team managers.

Rocky attended the City Park and Rec meeting, and reported that there have been people seen riding four/two wheel motor vehicles on the fields. These people can and will be cited by the city and/or proper authorities.

Rocky handed out the flyers for the 100 inning fund-raiser with detailed information for the Blood Drive.

Rocky stated that the division reps need to play a big part in communicating participation and rules to all teams.

Balboa baseball league has given the league permission to use the baseball field and snack-bar for the date of the 100 inning fund-raising event.

Treasurer's Report:

Rick stated that the flyer for the Blood Drive went up on Angelina Held's website. He reported that appointments are being scheduled to donate blood but that the league needs more volunteers to schedule.

Rick informed the board of the current funds in the league's account (Approx. \$20,000). If the fund-raiser turns out well, the league should even out.

Rick discussed concerns regarding the 100 inning game fund-raiser such as, rules, league participation, pledge forms for all teams (regardless of player attendance), etc.

In order to have the tournament run as efficiently as possible, all teams will have equipment outside of the dugouts. Division Reps will score keep for the games.

Rick informed the board of the maximum potential for league earnings which could come close to \$10,000.00.

Rick discussed the process of this year's new 100 inning game fund-raiser being a learning experience for the league.

Schedules are to be made for team volunteers to attend the snack-bar and barbeque.

It is the team mom's responsibility to collect pledge forms and money from all team players.

The team who raises the most money for the league will win a team batting session with Rip City.

LeeAnn and Rip City volunteered to umpire and feed the pitching machines during the games.

Carol will lend her generator and easy-ups to the league for the event.
Mountain Mike's pizza will donate three pizzas for the fund-raiser.

Barb asked about holding a coach/manager's meeting prior to the fund-raiser in order to familiarize everyone with the rules and details of the event.

Old Business: Kim has been in contact with Mike from Closet World, who will be sending a designer out to the field tomorrow and will work on plans to finish the remodel.

Don Cole is in charge of purchasing new sprinklers for all fields, they are tentatively scheduled to be installed the week of spring break

Rocky stated that the league was under budget for the cost of all 250 uniforms for the league, including staff hats and shirts.

By laws will be posted on the website.

New Business:

Mandatory meeting for coaches/managers Friday 3/24/06 at 6:00pm to discuss details of the 100 inning game.

Patti suggested purchasing a new grill for the league.

Barb motioned to allow \$550.00 for a new grill, Patti seconded the motion, all members were in favor, and the motion was approved.

Player conduct and behavior were discussed, also possible reprimands for unacceptable player behavior/language, were discussed. Rocky recommended posting player code of conduct on the website.

Matt brought up discussion on this year's all-star selection, should the selection be different?
How to make the selection as fair as possible.
